# Fabric Wrapped Canvas

## Materials Needed:

- 12" x 12" Canvas, or dimension of choice
- 16" x 16" piece of fabric
- Iron
- Staple Gun
- Framing Hardware (optional)
- Floater Frame (optional)



## Instructions:

1. Press fabric to avoid any undesired creases in finished work.
2. Lay fabric wrong side up and position canvas face down in the center of the fabric.
3. Fold fabric around canvas as if wrapping a gift pulling tight to prevent gapping. Using staple gun, secure fabric to the back surface of the wood frame (the part of the canvas frame that will lay flat against the wall).
4. Continue to wrap and staple the remaining 3 canvases edges in the same fashion.

*Optional:* for a gallery presentation secure fabric wrapped canvases in floater frames and hang in a series on a wall.

# Fabric Wrapped Canvas

## Materials Needed:

- 12" x 12" Canvas, or dimension of choice
